The speaker discussed the various aspects of museum activities and also highlighted how a spirit of archiving should be nurtured among the college students.



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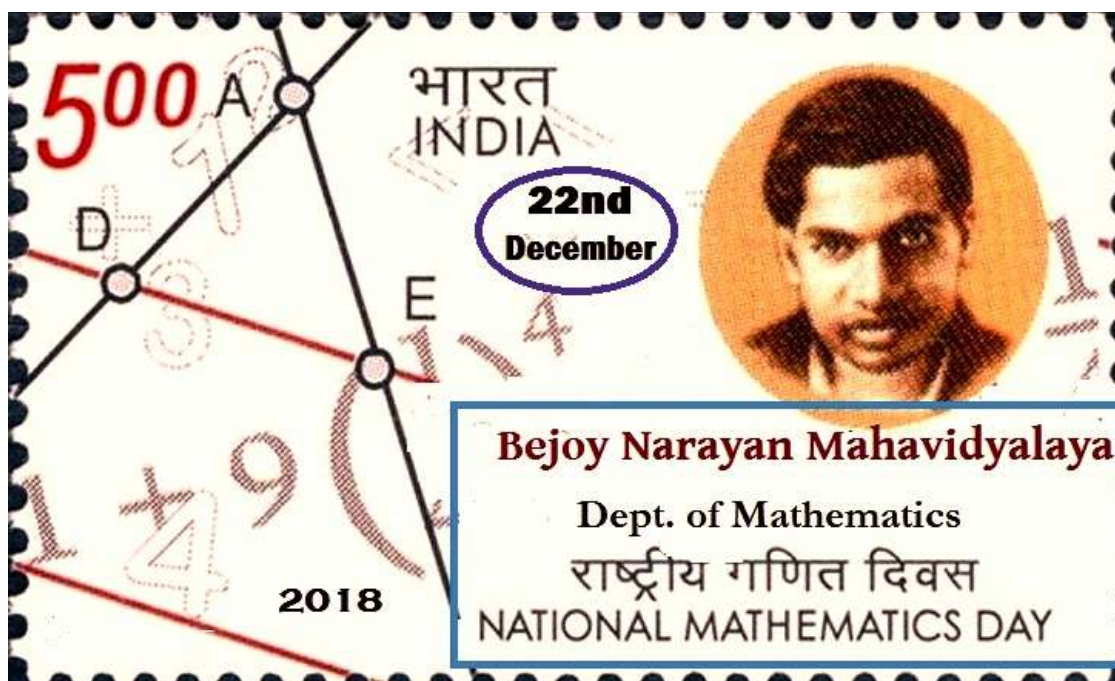
Celebration of National Mathematics Day and Invited lecture on The Mathematical works of Sir Ashutosh Mukherjee (organized by Dept. of Mathematics)

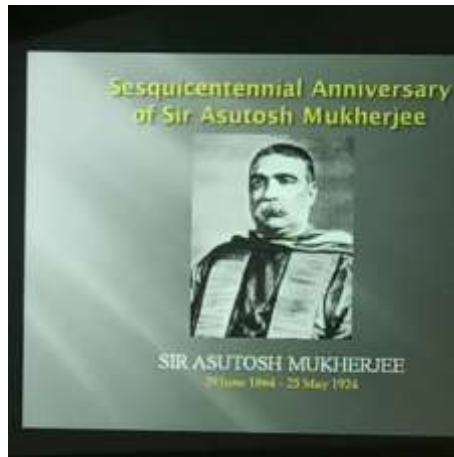

The chief speaker for the programme was **Dr. Subhen Mitra, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Mathematics, Sri Gopal Banerjee College, West Bengal.**

Women's empowerment has been a key concept and major goal in development discourse since the 1990s. There is a particularly strong narrative linking women's empowerment with women's Capacity building. Capacity building is the development of knowledge, skills and attitudes in individuals and groups of people relevant in the design, development and maintenance of institutional and operational infrastructures and processes.

The purpose of this conference is to articulate that both empowerment and capacity building are concerned with the processes by which people become aware of their own interests and how these relate to those of others. Capacity building is thus more than simply opening up access to decision-making; it must also include the processes that lead people to perceive themselves as able and entitled to occupy that decision-making space. The deliberations will focus on surrounding socio-economic and linguistic-cultural contexts with special emphasis on challenges and policies for real capacity building for women from different economic strata. The seminar intends to draw special attention to the domestic realm where women's capacity building critically depends on intra household negotiation and relationships with a focus on the application of technology. The seminar expects to offer certain guidelines for a gender neutral ambience towards capacity building.
