

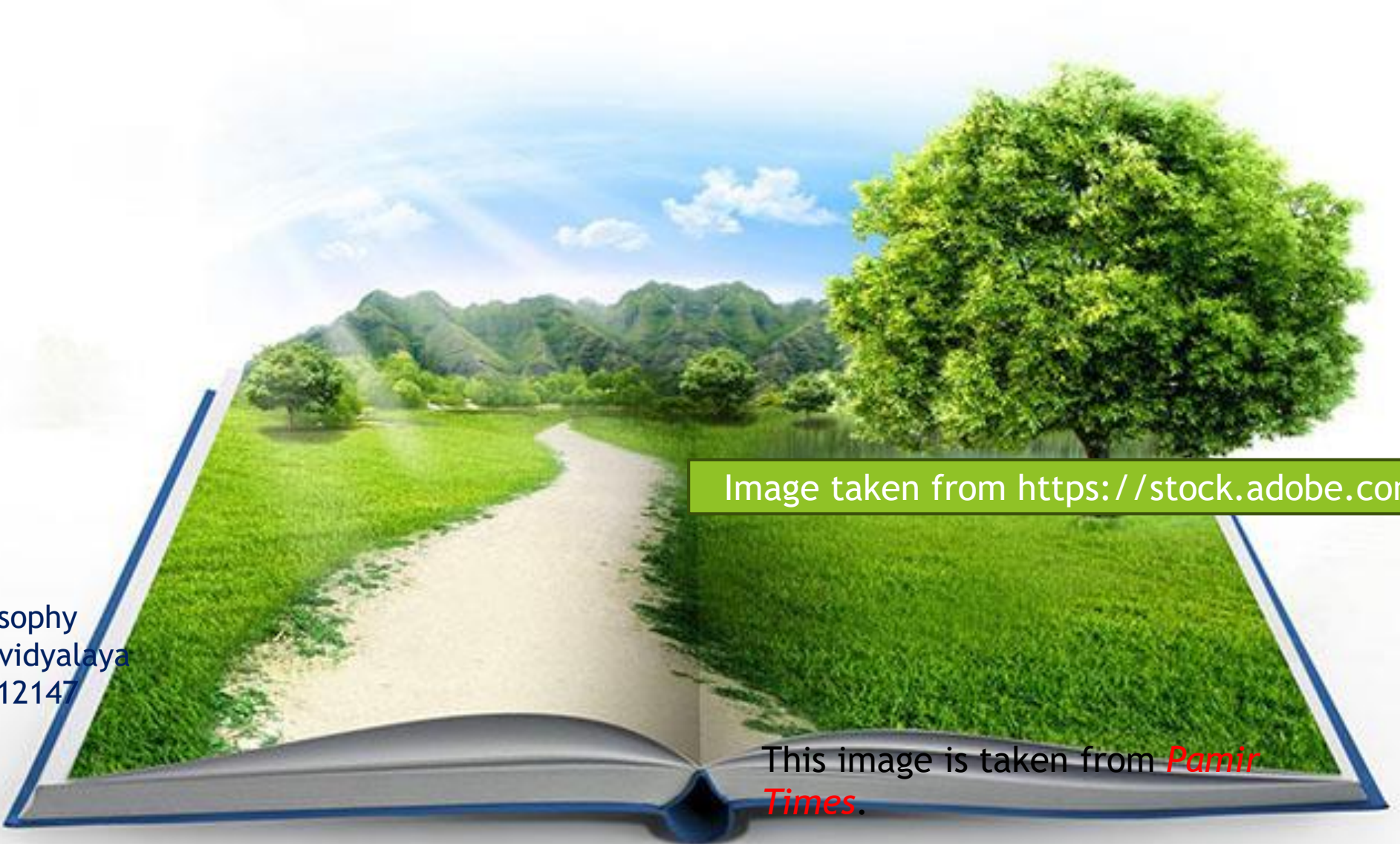

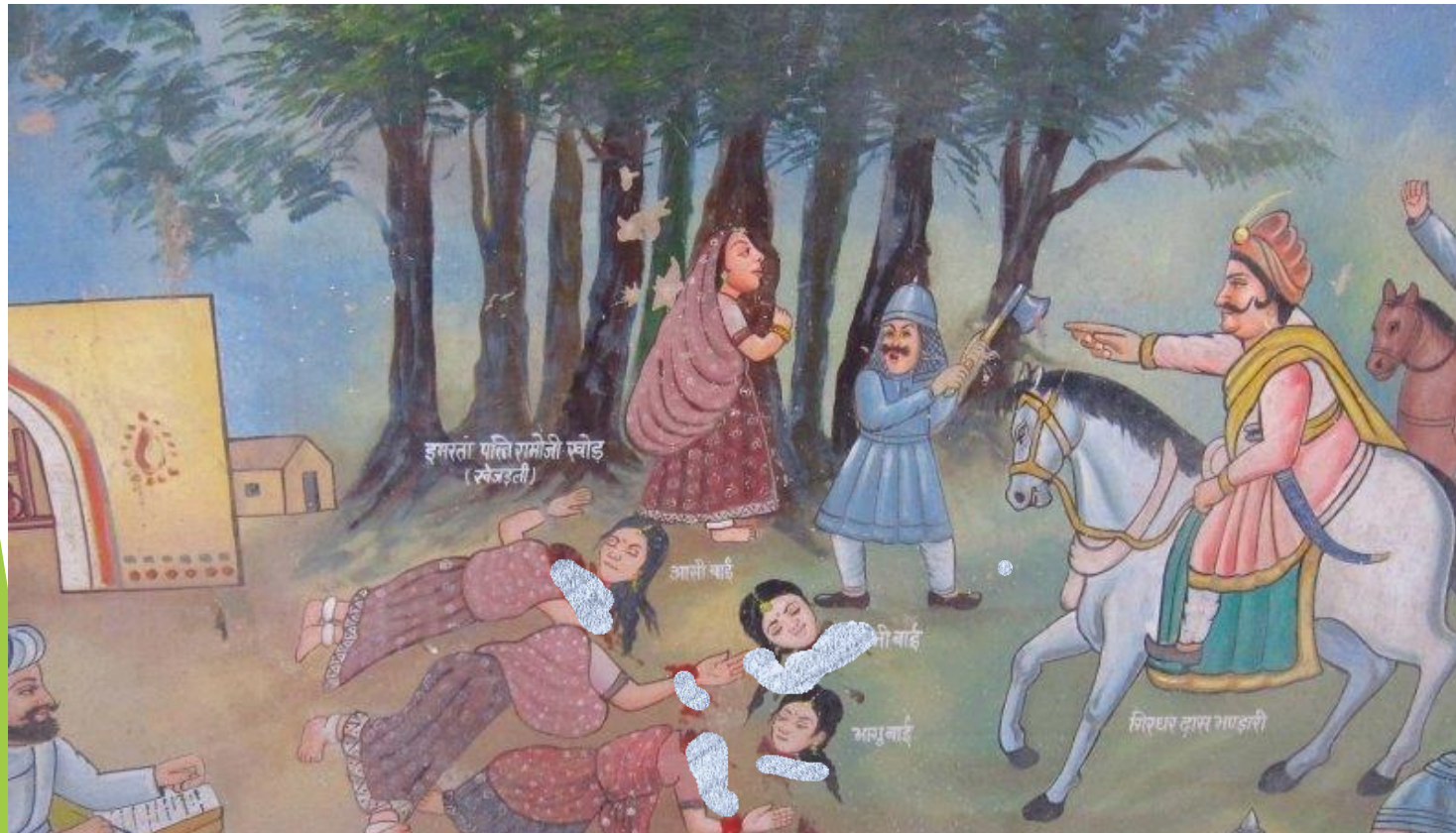


# Environmental ethics

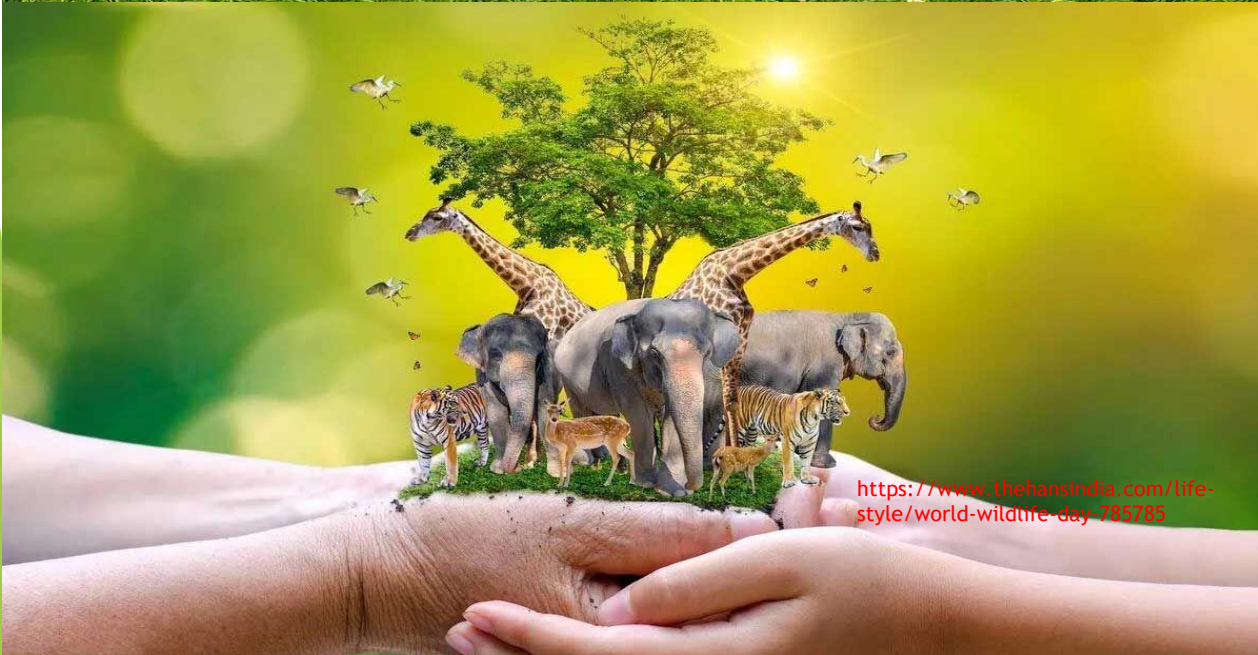

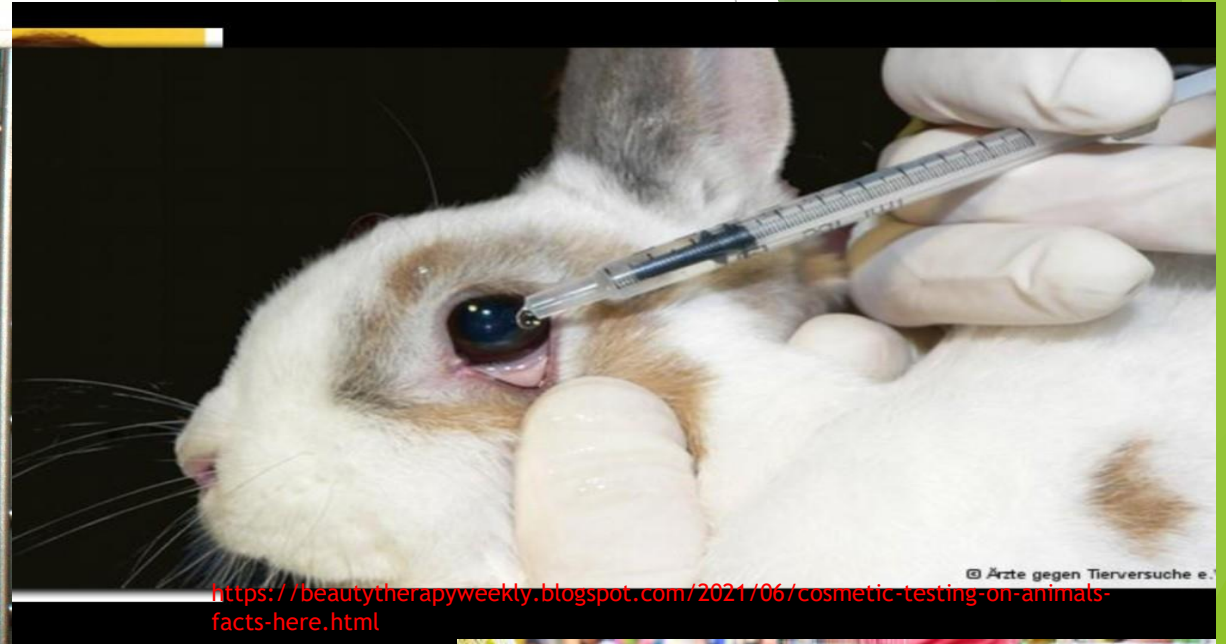
