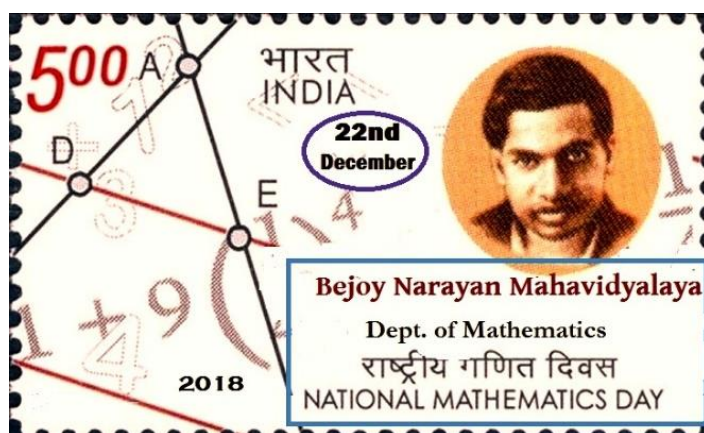
1. Seminar on *Internet on Things* on 11.01.2017

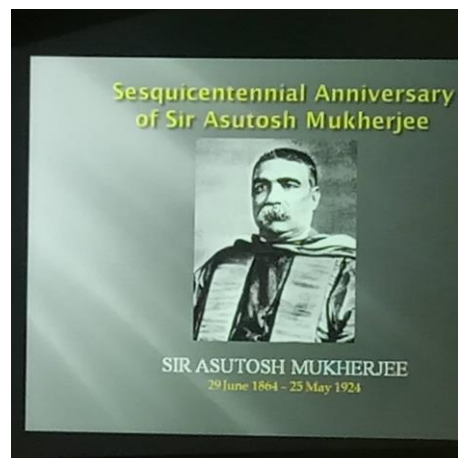


2. Celebration of *National Mathematics Day* on 22.12.2018

In honour of the famous mathematician Srinivasa Ramajunan, 22nd December is celebrated as the National Mathematics Day in India. On 22.12.2018, the Department of Mathematics, Bejoy Narayan Mahavidyalaya celebrated the said occasion by arranging an invited lecture and a student seminar. The chief speaker for the programme was **Dr. Subhen Mitra, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Mathematics, Sri Gopal Banerjee College, West Bengal.**



The programme started with the introductory address by the HoD (Dept. of Mathematics, Bejoy Narayan Mahavidyalaya) Sri Dwijendra Nath Bar. Dr. Rajesh Mondal and other teachers of the department also spoke briefly about the significance of the occasion. Then, Dr. Subhen Mitra delivered an informative lecture on the mathematical works of Sri Asutosh Mukherjee, the eminent educationist of Bengal. After this lecture, Subhendu Pramanick, a student of the department discussed the many events of Srinivasa Ramajunan's life. Finally, there were seminar presentations by the students on Real Analysis and other mathematical topics. **65** persons (including students) attended the programme.

On 5th February, 2021, the Department of Mathematics, Bejoy Narayan Mahavidyalaya, in collaboration with Dept. of Mathematics, Balagarh Bijoy Krishna Mahavidyalaya, organized a one-day International webinar on the Life and Works of P C Mahalanobis. The programme consisted of three invited lectures and a contributory paper-reading session. The webinar was held through the Google Meet platform.

The programme started with the introductory address by Dr. Raibatak Sen Gupta (Convener of the webinar) and Dr. Biswajit Paul (Joint Convener of the programme), who represented Bejoy Narayan Mahavidyalaya and Balagarh Bijoy Krishna Mahavidyalaya, respectively. The first invited speaker in the webinar was **Srimati Bulbul Mahalanobis from Bangladesh, who is not only a relative of PC Mahalanobis but also a muktijoddha, author and noted singer (associated with the Swadhin Bangla Betar Kendro)**. She spoke on the influence of Rabindranath on the life of Prasantachandra Mahalanobis. The second invited speaker for the occasion was **Dr. Arindam**

Gupta, Assistant Professor, Department of Statistics, The University of Burdwan. He discussed the role of PC Mahalanobis as the father of Indian statistical study. This concluded the first session.


