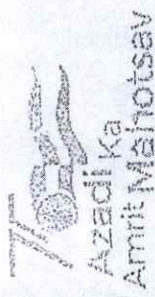

PLAN OF ACTION

A PART PROGRAMME OF AZADI KA AMRUT MAHOTSAV

Prelude:

As India is completing 75 years of independence, a series of events are being organised by various Ministries as a part of "Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav". Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports would organise "World Bicycle Day" on 3rd June 2022.

Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, proposes to organise World Bicycle Day by involving its pioneer youth organisations viz. Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) & National Service Scheme (NSS) with the support of their vast network of Youth Volunteers spread across the country.

Objective:

- To celebrate 75 years of India's Independence- Azad Ka Amrut Mahotsav
- To cherish and follow the noble ideas that inspired freedom struggle
- Enhance the spirit of Brotherhood and Nationalism
- To popularise the usage of cycling to solve the dual issues of global warming and unhealthy lifestyle

Plan for the Event:

World Bicycle Day will be celebrated as per the following:

- Launching on 3rd June 2022 from Delhi
- Events at 75 Iconic Places on 3rd June 2022
- Block level Bicycle Rally from 4th June 2022 to 10th June 2022

Role of other Ministries/Deptts:

Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports; the Nodal/Lead Ministry will need to coordinate with various Ministries and Deptts, local offices of Central Ministries to organize the World Bicycle Day:

- Culture Ministry- Local Troupes for launch event, at 75 iconic places.
- Ministry of Education- Identification of 750 young cyclists and 1000 participants for the launch event at Delhi on 3rd June. Schools to build projects showcasing Bicycles@2047.

- Department of Sports- Sports professionals like Virat Kohli, Neeraj Chopra, PV Sindhu, others from different fields to be invited.
- FICCI/CII – Paddle for India- Stationary Bikes branded with AKAM logo at multiple public spaces. Public encouraged to log kilometres. Same in INR donated to specific causes by cycle brands and other corporates.
- Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change- Event to focus on reviving cycling as a norm to lower global warming.
- Ministry of External Affairs- Social Media Amplification
- Delhi Police- Law & Order
- Ministry of Urban Development- Route permission and other logistic arrangements for the launch event.
- Ministry of I&B: Doordarshan, AIR, PIB, other print and electronic media channels to be channelised for coverage of the event.

Organizational Modalities:

Timeline: 3rd June 2022 to 14th June 2022

1. LAUNCH EVENT:

Date: 3rd June 2022

Venue: yet to be decided

Expected Participation: 750 cyclists and 1000 other volunteers

Implementing Agency: NYKS, Delhi

Venue: SD New Delhi to scout for location bearing in mind the following points:

Capacity of the venue, Indoor/Outdoor, Traffic and Law and order arrangement, Stage details, seating plan

Implementation Committee: The Implementation Committee consisting of representatives from DoS, DoYA, NSS, NYKS, SAI, Khelo India, to be formed for coordination, monitoring and implementation of the event. This committee may decide upon:

- a) Identification of Equipment-Cycles etc. required Inviting Bids from various Agencies for execution/ organisation of the Event while mentioning the outline of the event and technical requirement
- b) Sending invitations to the attendees/ Guests/ Dignitaries

SD NYKS New Delhi to ensure the following:

- Identification of Venue and route of cycling
- Identification of Youth cyclists
- Planning the movement of Youth Cyclists
- Arrangement of Cycles for the participants
- Provision of Food and refreshment at the venue
- Volunteers for manning of refreshment stations

The selected EMA may be assigned the following responsibilities:

- Creating Pre Event Buzz through various media & social media platforms
- Creation of videos and content/tweets for social media
- Branding of event- design of certificates, backdrop, banner, e-posters, logo, etc.
- Setting up of refreshment stations en-route for cyclists

2. EVENTS AT 75 ICONIC LOCATIONS

Date: 3rd June 2022

Coverage: 75 iconic locations

Expected Participation: 5625 participants (75*per location)

Preparatory Activities:

- a) State Directors to entrust the concerned DDs/DYOs to visit the respective locations assigned by NYKS HQ for the event and make elaborate plans w.r.t route (minimum 7.5km) time, VIP engagement, provision for stage/dias, Pre programme buzz, branding of event.
- b) Partnership with Cycling Clubs, Sports Club, Fitness Centres, NSS, Sports Department, etc. of the locality to ensure participation of 75 Youth Cyclists.
- c) Local resources would be mobilised in addition to the funds provided to ensure successful implementation of the event.
- d) Identification and invitation to Ministers/MPs/MLAs any other eminent persons/VIPs for inauguration/flag off
- e) Press release of the planned events

Implementation Strategy:

1. The rally may be held in early morning 6.00 am to 9.00 am
2. Banners would display **Fit India Freedom Rider Cycle Rally** and caps having the logo of AKAM would be distributed to the participants.
3. Before the flag off, garlanding of portraits, floral tributes at statues/memorials would be done.
4. VIPs to flag off the rally of 7.5km (minimum)
5. During the journey, locals would be encouraged to join the rally.
6. At the finish point, refreshment would be provided to the participants.
7. Conclusion of the event with National Anthem.

Media and Social Media Strategy:

- Efforts would be made to create pre programme buzz on social media handles of NYKS and by issuing press release in all States and Districts.
- Print, electronic and social media would be used extensively through Facebook photo frames, Instagram Reels, Event Tweets, Quizes, posts, e-posters, etc.
- Celebrity endorsement Videos by Ministers, Actors, Sports personalities, Yoga Gurus, Fitness Enthusiasts would be shared on social media handles with the hashtags such as #AKAM #AzadiKaAmrutMahotsav #BicycleRally #WorldBicycleDay2022 #FitIndia FreedomRider
- Doordarshan, AIR, PIB, other print and electronic media channels would be informed in advance for coverage of the event.

3. BLOCK LEVEL FIT INDIA FREEDOM RIDER CYCLE RALLY

Coverage: 5889 Blocks in 601 Districts

Duration: 4th June 2022 to 10th June 2022

Expected Participation: 1,17,780 participants (20 per Block in 5889 Blocks)

Preparatory Activities:

- a. Every DYO would identify locations associated with India's freedom struggle (freedom fighter, Historical Place or at memorials associated with the martyrs) in each block of the District.
- b. State Directors to ensure that the schedule of Districts is prepared in such a way that Fit India Freedom Rider Cycle Rally is conducted on all 30 days across the State
- c. Identification of 20 Youth cyclists in each block.
- d. Coordination with Cycling Clubs, Sports Club, Fitness Centres, NSS, Sports Department, etc. for ensuring Jan Bhagidari
- e. Local resources would be mobilised in addition to the funds provided to ensure successful implementation of the event.
- f. Identification and invitation to eminent persons/VIPs/Peoples' Representatives for inauguration/flag off
- g. On 3rd June 2022, one Cycle Rally of 7.5km shall be held in the HQ block to mark the launch of the month long Fit India Freedom Rider Cycle Rally.
- h. Press release of the planned events

Implementation Strategy:

- a. The rally may be held in early morning 6.00 am to 9.00 am or in the evening, considering the local situation.
- b. Banners would display **Fit India Freedom Rider Cycle Rally** and caps having the logo of AKAM would be distributed to the participants.
